

## REGULATIONS for ALL HORSE RINGS & COMPETITORS BEHAVIOUR

Horse exhibitors MUST present a horse health declaration, waybill and/ or Queensland travel permit for ALL horses moving onto Affiliated Agricultural Society Show Grounds.

This Show will be running under the QCAS special horse regulations, copies of these regulations are available at the nomination box or through

1. All horse vehicles must come through the Horse Competitors gate at MacGregor Street.
2. All Stallions and Colts 2 yrs. and over must be correctly bitted whilst in hand. At NO time may a Stallion be handled by a person under the age of 18 yrs. of age.
3. All horse vehicles, when requested by stewards to move, must do so.
4. The committee has the right to refuse any exhibit without a reason and NO correspondence will be entered into.
5. Age of horses to be computed from 1st August - NB Any person willfully giving wrong ages or untrue copies of livestock will be disqualified and otherwise dealt with as the committee may direct.
6. All exhibitors are to pay admission fees regardless of the number of entries.
7. Post entries on the day of the show.
8. In approximate order, which shall not be binding, subject to alterations at the discretion of Stewards, Judging commences at the time specified in the ring on Saturday & Sunday.
9. No rings will be required to wait if there is a clash in another ring.
10. Ribbons for First, Second and Third in each Class.
11. All horses to be controlled to the satisfaction of the Stewards.
12. Any competitor may be instructed by the Ring Master or Assistant to move any horse that is considered a danger to other competitors.
13. Registration papers from Bred Association must be produced upon request from Stewards.
14. A Maiden is a horse that has not won first prize in a similar event, at any affiliated show.
15. A Novice is a horse that has not won an open champion Hack at any Agricultural Show.
16. Stallions are NOT permitted in Hack classes.
17. Pony Hacks must not exceed 14hh.
18. All small pony hacks/hunter ponies under 12.2hh to be ridden by a rider under 18years of age.
19. A Galloway Hack shall be 14hh and NE 15hh.
20. A Park Hack is a registered riding pony over 14.2hh NE 15hh.
21. Park Hack 14hh NE 15hh riding pony.
22. Show Hunters are NOT eligible to compete in Hack events.
23. Owner Rider classes are for home produced horses ridden by the owner or an immediate family member. The owner/rider must not derive any income from showing or instructing. (other than prize money)
