All entries –

1. Completed entry form with class listed and age if high school or primary school.
2. Art to be framed and ready to hang with D rings and wire.
3. Artworks must be 2D and not exceed 100cm x 100cm including frame.
4. Each piece of art must contain your name, contact details, class no, and price if for sale.

Please NFS (not for sale) if this applies.

5. Artwork must be original work and not entered in a previous Laidley show.
6. Laidley show society takes 10% commission of any art work sold.
7. Images showing violence, weapons or nudity will be rejected.
8. Limit of 2 entries per class

Open classes

1. Oil/acrylic – any subject
2. Portrait – any medium
3. Watercolour – any subject
4. Drawing – (including pencil, pastel, ink, charcoal)
5. Abstract – any subject, mixed medium.
6. Show Theme – 'Krome Rock & Roll'
7. Landscape/Seascape – any medium.
8. Still Life – any subject, any medium.

High School (Entry free) Art does not have to be framed.

9. Any subject, any medium

Primary school (Entry free) Art does not have to be framed.
