HIGH SCHOOL DISPLAY

Each School is allocated 2 cabinets to display their school work. School display may be set up prior to the show by 1 - 3 weeks due to school holidays. All exhibits to be in place no later than Tuesday 30th June 2026. Judging will take place Friday 3rd July 2026.

Display should showcase students work from the last 12 months and reflect learning. Work should be selected from a variety of ages, subjects. Display area is 2mtr wide x 1 mtr deep and 1.8mtr high

This space can be used to advertise upcoming events at the school using a A4 size poster.

PRIMARY SCHOOL DISPLAY – Theme – ‘Krome Rock & Roll’

One display per school. Entry – FREE - Prize ribbons for 1st, 2nd, 3rd
