- **Judging:** Friday 5th July 2024 at 11:00 am - Only Stewards are to communicate with the judge while judging is in progress. Spectators welcome.
- All entries must be grown by the exhibitor and be of acceptable quality.
- No entry may be entered in two distinct classes.
- Exhibits must meet schedule requirements eg number or species specified
- Fruit and vegetables to have stems left on.
